Deadline for Abstract Submission: Thursday, June 13, 2019

Abstracts (PDF) for both spoken papers and poster sessions must be in English of no more than 500 words in length and will appear in the Conference Program for all presenters. The Abstract should include the following 9 categories (select one of them):

- 1) History; Philosophy; Aesthetics; Sociology
- 2) Cognitive and Developmental Psychology
- 3) Early Childhood Care and Education
- 4) School Education (Curriculum; Teaching Materials; Assessment)
- 5) Teacher Education; Social Education; Lifelong Learning; Environmental Education
- 6) Music Therapy; Special Needs Education
- 7) Ethno Musicology; Popular Music Studies
- 8) Technology; Educational Technology
- 9) The Others

The abstract should include your name, affiliation. Please let us know your home & email address and mobile phone number on your text message.
